The Parochial Pen

My dear parishioners,

As previously indicated, the linkage between Queen of the Apostles Parish and Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish will be effective on <u>July 1, 2025</u>, upon the retirement of Father Sladicka, the current pastor of Avoca. Bishop Bambera has appointed me as Pastor of the new linkage. I will continue to reside in Sacred Heart Rectory but maintain parish offices in both rectories. Kathy Vojta will continue to serve as parish secretary of Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish and Kathy Hudzinski will serve as the new parish secretary of Queen of Apostles Parish.

For the past several weeks a "Transition Team" has met to plan a path forward and recommend a new schedule of Masses for both parishes. Father Sladicka and I selected team members to help prepare for the upcoming linkage. Nancy Adomiak, Lisa Allardyce, Maryanne Bennie, Michael Jake, Ed Kovaleski, and Jane Maxwell represented Avoca. Gene Bartosiewicz, Jeremy Collins, Kathleen Hudzinski, Tina Petcaugh, Bethany Purdy, and William Satkowski represented Dupont. I thank them for their kind service to our parishes. They worked well together to recommend a new Mass schedule.

A new Mass schedule for both of our parishes is announced in our bulletins this weekend. Three primary considerations directed the process of creating this schedule. First, the ability of children to attend both Sunday school and Sunday Mass with their families in either church. Second, a desire to maintain as much continuity as possible with the historic Mass times. Third, an intent to preserve those Mass times and locations with the highest attendance. While this new schedule may require us to make some small adaptations to our weekend schedules, it is my belief, shared with the Transition Team members, that it will accommodate well the spiritual obligations of the faithful in both parishes. Do not see the new schedule as losing a Mass but rather gaining one. Soon, our parishioners from both parishes will have FOUR Mass options to choose each weekend instead of three. Parishioners from both parishes may attend Masses in either church and deposit their offertory envelopes in the collection basket to be credited to their respective parish.

Please be attentive to the bulletin in the weeks and months ahead as more information will be forthcoming regarding details of the pastoral, liturgical, catechetical and social developments in our linked parishes. In the meantime, contact me or any transition team member if you have questions about the linkage process. Continue to pray for both parish communities during this time of transition. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us! Saint Mary, Queen of Apostles, pray for us!

**Picnic food tickets** will be sold advance before and after Masses on May 31/June 1, June 7/8, and June 14 in the church narthex.

Columbarium niches and Mausoleums plots are available: A <u>columbarium</u> for the interment of cremains is located in the Holy Sepulchre section of our cemetery. It is a 120 niche octagonal marble structure that will be accessible by way of a sidewalk from Pine St. The pricing for the niches of our columbarium -

Level 1 (bottom): \$1,100 for single space, \$2,200 for double

Level 2: \$1,200 single, \$2,400 double Level 3: \$1,300 single, \$2,600 double

Level 4: \$1,300 single, \$2,600 double

Level 5 (top): \$1,300 single, \$2,600 double

In the Gethsemani section of our cemetery, at the corner of Wyoming Ave. and Oak St., ground has been aside solely for the placement of <u>mausoleums</u>. Both double (for two people to be entombed side by side) and single (for one person) mausoleums are available. Cost of plot for private family mausoleum - Single width: \$4,000, Stacking privilege: \$2,000 per tier (3 tier max), Double width: \$6,000, Stacking privilege: \$3,000 per tier (3 tier max). If you would like to purchase a columbarium niche or a mausoleum plot, contact our Parish Office to make an appointment. Also, a portion of the Calvary section of our parish cemetery has been designated for <u>green burials</u>. Call the parish office if you have any questions regarding an environmentally healthy green burial.
